

Spanish: *SPAN 1411-Beginning Spanish I*. You will develop language skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing. You will also acquire the vocabulary and grammatical structures to communicate and comprehend at the beginning level according to ACTFL guidelines (2012). You will continue with study of the language and will also have access to lab and other learning materials.

Follow up with SPAN 1412-Beginning Spanish II, SPAN 2311-Intermediate Spanish II followed with SPAN 2312-Intermediate Spanish II.



French: FREN 1411-Beginning French I. This is basic language skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing. You will acquire the vocabulary and grammatical structures necessary to communicate and comprehend at the beginner level. Next, sign up for FREN 1412-Beginning French II, which is a continuation of what was covered in the first course. The las course offered in French is FREN 2312—Intermediate French II.



Chinese: CHIN 1411-Beginning Chinese I which is basic Chinese language skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing within a cultural framework. You will acquire the vocabulary and grammatical structures necessary to communicate and comprehend at the beginner level. The next course is CHIN 1412-Beginning Chinese II. This course continues the development of basic Chinese language skills and prepares you to CHIN 2311-Intermediate Chinese I. The last course offered is CHIN 2312-Intermediate Chinese II.
